

## KA HAKU ROAD CLOSURES

Ka Haku / Roundabout Road Repair Begins Wednesday, September 7, 2022, and will last about 6 weeks.

Our neighboring community association, P2CA, owns the stretch of Ka Haku Road from the highway entrance to about where the Anini Trail is located. P2CA has scheduled much-needed repairs to the damaged sections of concrete on Ka Haku Road from the highway to the roundabout.

P2CA will host a town hall meeting to discuss the road repair project as well as the traffic pattern changes at the Ka Haku roundabout so that it operates like other roundabouts on the island.

The road work will affect traffic and events at and around Prince Albert Park and the Princeville Community Center. **The Saturday farmers' market will not take place at Prince Albert Park during the road work.** The event host is currently looking for an alternate location. Give yourself extra time to get where you need to be, please drive with aloha, be mindful of the neighborhood residents as you follow the detour signs, and be kind to the construction crew as they work to improve the road conditions. The road repair schedule is below; it is approximate, weather permitting, and subject to change. On the maps, **RED** indicates the road section is closed; **GREEN** indicates the road section is open.

Phase 1: Sept. 7 - Sept. 21

Ka Haku Road entrance from the highway is closed entirely.

The roundabout is open.
Use Lei O Papa Road to enter and exit Princeville.
Follow the detour signs.



## Phase 2: Sept. 22 - Oct. 6

Ka Haku Road from just past the roundabout to the highway is **open only for exiting Princeville**. Cannot enter Princeville from Ka Haku Road at the highway.

To enter Princeville, use Lei O Papa Road. Follow the detour signs.

From Queen Emma's Drive, only a left turn is allowed.



## Phase 3: Oct. 7 - Oct. 19

Ka Haku Road from just past the roundabout to the highway is **open only for exiting Princeville**. Cannot enter Princeville from Ka Haku Road at the highway.

To enter Princeville, use Lei O Papa Road. Follow the detour signs.

From Queen Emma's Drive, only a slight right-turn jog is allowed to connect to the western lane of Ka Haku Road.
