Parking	Park in garage overnight and in designated parking spot during the day. Parking in front of the garage is never authorized, except for loading and unloading. Do not drive on grass or on sprinkler heads!
Pool/BBQ	Hours are from 8:00 am to 10:00 pm. Access by key provided in your unit. No glass allowed in pool area. No diving or running. Pool is a quiet area. Children playing is fine but no screaming or loud music! Be considerate of the neighbors. Shower and wash sand off feet before entering. No children under 5 are allowed in the hot tub. Communal BBQ at the pool – Timed valve next to unit. please clean after use and turn off burners.
Beach	Please be VERY CAREFUL when at the beach and on trails. Many people lose their lives here every year due to rip tides, or being swept off rocks by set waves. When in doubt, STAY OUT! Swim at lifeguarded beaches.
Bugs, Food	Mosquitoes are a nuisance – please keep screens closed at all times. Keep counters clean to avoid attracting ants and roaches. Keep all opened food in the fridge and seal up chips and crackers right away.
Groceries	The closest store is Foodland at the Princeville shopping center. Sign up for a Maika'i card for discounts. Don't miss the farmers markets for fresh, organic fruit and veggies. Google for schedule and location. Costco, Safeway, Walmart and Target located in Lihue.
Trash & Recycling	Break down all boxes and trash before placing in dumpster. Bins for cans and plastic bottles marked HI5 are located by each dumpster. If you desire to recycle other items, you must personally take them to the Transfer Station on Kuhio Highway. Please try to recycle items as much as possible to preserve our landfill. Avoid plastic bottles as they are terrible for the environment.
Security	Use common sense when dealing with personal security. Close and lock all doors when out of the house, and don't leave valuables unattended in your car or at the beach.
Water & Power	Please conserve water usage in your unit. Take quick showers and minimize toilet flushing. Kauai water from the tap is safe to drink. Conserve electricity by turning off lights and Air Conditioning when not in use. The majority of electricity on Kauai is generated by burning Diesel fuel! Conversion to solar will take many decades to complete.
